

ALL-ENERGY CONFERENCE – NISSAN LEAF VIEWING PROMOTION

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

How to Enter:

Victorian residents aged 18 years or above must receive the Nissan LEAF eDM distributed by email on 1 October 2010, and follow the link to send an email to supply their full name, address, email address and contact mobile phone number to the Promoter. The first twenty (20) valid entries received will win a ticket to attend a special viewing of the Nissan LEAF vehicle at the All-Energy Conference in Melbourne between 3:00pm and 4:30pm AEDT on Wednesday 6 October 2010.
